

GENERAL SUPPLY TERMS

These supply specifications must be considered an integral part of the offer and/or contractual agreements between Angoscini MP S.r.l. (vendor) and its Client/Customer (buyer) and therefore are understood as fully accepted. Condition's updates are any time available by consulting the following web address: angoscini.it/terms.pdf.

QUALITY OF THE SUPPLY

The supplies are carried out using non-reconditioned top-quality materials conforming to the technical specifications indicated in the offer, except for cases in which an agreement is in force with the buyer. The supplied products conform to the samples approved during the product definition phase.

UNI EN 22768-1:1996 class C and class V tolerances are applied. For extruded parts cut "to measure" the tolerance on the length is +/-10mm. Tolerances different from generally applied ones must be agreed by both parties and defined by a technical drawing.

SUPPLIED GUARANTEE

In agreement with applicable laws, Angoscini MP S.r.l is not liable for any damage suffered by the Client for faults not directly attributable to Angoscini MP S.r.l. Angoscini MP S.r.l.'s liability, for all losses or damages suffered by the Client resulting from faults, lack of quality or any other hypothesis of total or partial non-fulfillment, may not, in any case, exceed reimbursement of the purchase price. Any complaint must be made within 10 days of receiving the goods. The materials used by Angoscini MP S.r.l are guaranteed. The guarantee is limited to free substitution of the parts which we may recognize as faulty due to materials or imperfect processing.

PRODUCTION AND CHANGES OF DIES, MAINTENANCE, INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY

Angoscini MP S.r.l. is committed to the production and procedural management of dies ordered by the buyer, according to the methods indicated in the sale offer. The timescales relating to delivery of the equipment shall begin from the date the advance payment agreed by the two parties is registered (excluding August, December and festivities) and exclude enhancements not covered by reaching the indicated tolerances. Once processing is finished, a free sample will be delivered which must be approved by the buyer. Any changes to the product after the dies have been produced will require a feasibility study and, in any case, may be made after approval of the sample relating to the design before the requested change. The ordered dies remain the exclusive property of Angoscini MP S.r.l. until full payment of the supply. The buyer shall be required to bear maintenance charges or dies modification costs, if related dies belong to him. Angoscini MP S.r.l. is not responsible for breaches of intellectual and industrial property occurred by the buyer during the design phase of the product, for which the realization is commissioned on somebody else's behalf.

DELIVERY, RETURNS, PACKAGING AND TRANSPORT

The delivery date is specified on the commercial technical documents and indicates the date when the goods will be ready at our warehouse and is understood as ex warehouse.

The preparation times for the ordered material resulting from order confirmations are always approximate, legally non-binding and non-peremptory and, barring unforeseen circumstances, (as well as those of force majeure) which may occur during the order execution process, may not result in entitlement to requests for damage compensation and/or variation in the price and payment conditions stated in the order confirmation.

The buyer must pick up the ordered goods within 10 working days of the date the goods have been notified as ready and in any case within the calendar month in which the delivery date has been requested. If the buyer does not pick up the goods within the deadlines described above Angoscini MP S.r.l. reserves the right to invoice the goods and to start payment according to the agreed deadlines.

The quantities supplied may vary by -5% .- + 10% in quantity (sale unit) with respect to the order. Including if accepted the standard packaging materials proposed by Angoscini MP S.r.l. during the offer phase.

REVISION OF PRICES

Revision of prices is envisaged if there are any changes that cannot be absorbed by Angoscini MP S.r.l., such as, for example, increase in the price of raw materials and/or deterioration in the equipment used for processing the products which may cause reduction in productivity.

CONFIDENTIALITY AND MANAGEMENT OF PHOTOGRAPHIC MATERIAL

These conditions constitute a commitment for Angoscini MP S.r.l to use and keep all data, documents, information it may become aware of plus legal obligations relating to the Law Decree 196/2003 and EU regulation 2016/679 GDPR (privacy), secret and confidential.

The buyer consents to the creation of photographic material illustrating the product it owns, authorizing Angoscini MP S.r.l. to keep the photographs in its files and to use the same on diffusion means such as internet sites, digital platforms or paper-based material, acknowledging that the aims of such publications are of a merely advertising and promotion nature for the activity carried out by the vendor. Such disclaimer/authorization may be repealed at any time with a written communication to be sent by ordinary mail or e-mail.

JURISDICTION

Any dispute deriving from the interpretation, application, execution, termination of the contract and/or these "General supply conditions" or, in any case, relating to them shall be settled before the exclusive jurisdiction of the Court where the vendor has its registered headquarters (Court of Brescia), even in the case of consolidation of actions.

PRIVACY

With reference to EU regulation 2016/679, GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) we inform you that the data in our possession of a personal identification nature obtained directly from you during the contractual phase are processed for the purposes for which they have been collected. The data are registered on computerized and paper supports, in a legal manner, with maximum confidentiality and always in respect of the law. Individual data are processed only by internal personnel who are authorized following specific training, with the aim of making them co-responsible, for spreading the culture of data processing security. The granting of data is obligatory for implementing the existing contractual relationship.
